Outreach

Over the last six years, the Network has reached close to 75,000 beneficiaries through over 650 training events. In 2018, the CIFAL Global Network reached 23,190 beneficiaries around the world through 147 training events.

The substantial increase in training services and greater outreach reflects both, the expansion of the Network and the continued demand for capacity building at local and subnational levels. The CIFAL Global Network also offers training activities aimed at raising awareness of the Agenda 2030 for Sustainable Development including its 17 Goals and 169 Targets.


HIGHLIGHTS IN 2018

23,190 government officials, private sector representatives and civil society leaders from around the world participated in CIFAL centres activities.


More than 100 countries from Africa, Asia-Pacific, Europe, North, Central and South America, as well as from the Caribbean were reached in 2018.


OUR BENEFICIARIES (2013 - 2018)




BENEFICIARIES BY REGION





Strengthening road safety for sustainable cities

Road traffic injuries claim more than 1.2 million lives each year with a disproportionate impact on health and development. They are the ninth leading cause of death across all age groups globally and the leading cause among young people aged between 15 and 29 years.

UNITAR's initiative on road safety aims to contribute to achieve SDG 3.6 to halve the number of global deaths and injuries from road traffic accidents by 2020.



UNITAR jointly with its CIFAL Global Network provide training opportunities aimed at strengthening capacities of government officials at local and national levels to implement road safety strategies and programmes.

Changing road users' behavior on key risk factors for road traffic injuries (speed, drink-driving, distracted driving, and the failure to use helmets, seat belts and child restraints properly or at all) is a key component for improving road safety. UNITAR and its CIFAL Centres also contribute to improve road user behavior through advocacy efforts and by increasing awareness of risk factors.
